STEVE WOOD at the Black Stump - Growing your own delicious food at home. Steve is an Australian horticultural talk-back radio and gardening TV presenter, with more than 40 years' experience in wholesale nursery production. He has a special interest in showing people how easy it is to grow food at home. Steve will be sharing his knowledge and passion on how to grow backyard vegetables, build great soil and grow mushrooms in your home garden.

In the DEMO TENT there are free talks throughout the day on bee-keeping, composting, fermented foods, hemp and marron farming. At various locations, you can also hear talks on olive-growing and see demonstrations of woodturning, blacksmithing, rose and citrus pruning, sheep shearing and working sheep dogs. Details overleaf.

Welcome to the 2019 Balingup Small Farm Field Day.

Now in its 29th year, the Field Day continues to showcase many aspects of small farming, including how to care for the land and animals, how to grow trees and food, cooking with fresh, local ingredients and fashion and crafts made from natural products.

Our aim is to encourage innovation and sustainability and to enrich visitors' understanding of how to live the good life on the land.

The event is organized by a group of volunteers from the Balingup community and the profits made each year are used to help finance worthy community projects.

Overleaf you will find a map of the oval to help you find your way around, and a timetable of free events and entertainment. These include talks, demonstrations, fashion shows, music, and the ever-popular Kids' Kitchen.

In each corner of the main oval, you will find big maps with a list of stallholders. These four maps are identified with different coloured flags - blue, green, purple and pink. You may hear the announcer referring to the 'pink corner', or the 'blue corner' as a way of identifying an area or direction.



To help your day run smoothly, please note:

CHILDREN

Parents / carers are responsible for ensuring their children are adequately supervised at all times.

CASH

Tap n' go payment facilities are available at the main entry gates. Once inside, you may find cash is easier to use for your purchases. ATMs are available next to the Field Day Office, as shown on the map. We're sorry but the infrastructure in this small town is unable to support the use of EFTPOS machines at every individual stall.

FIRST AID

There is a St John's Ambulance stand on Pig Promenade, near the main food stalls. St John's will be performing CPR demonstrations at 10.30am and 12.30pm.

ASSISTANCE & INFORMATION

If you need assistance, please ask one of our committee volunteers. They are wearing high-vis T-shirts with the Field Day logo on them.

There is an information booth at the Field Day Office and announcements will be made throughout the day to let you know what's happening. Any lost children will be cared for at the Field Day Office.

MUSIC

Local musicians will be playing throughout the day on the stage and in the cafe in the Recreation Centre building. Seating is provided.

FOOD and DRINK

In addition to the many food stalls, morning tea, a cooked lunch and seating are available in the Recreation Centre building.

Free drinking water is available at locations marked by a tap on the map overleaf. Please refill your drink bottle and save waste!
